COUNCIL DISCUSSION ITEMS –

• An Ordinance of the City of Algona, Washington, amending AMC chapter 12.16 relating to building numbering and street names; amending AMC section 15.04.01 relating to uniform codes adopted. Jeff Stottlemyre, with the Valley Regional Fire Authority attended the meeting to answer any questions Council had regarding the changes. He mentioned a modification on page 10 subsection F to delete this section so that the City of Algona would be in line with all the other jurisdictions. The section F deletion read as:

F. All buildings that are classified as Group E.

Exception: An automatic sprinkler system is not required in any area below the lowest level of exit discharge serving that area where every classroom throughout the building has at least one exterior exit door at ground level.


ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS -


