

He provided some literature from MRSC and before a city can reduce a speed limit it must first develop procedures to do so. The speed limit can only be lowered to 20 mph. Mayor Pro Tem Thomas said he would like to see the traffic calming interest form distributed to the residents for some feedback. Council member Osborn mentioned installing a fence to keep the kids safe. She also suggested to having the radar trailers set up on all of the dead end streets to get actual speed readings throughout the City. Jimmy and Sergeant Schrimpsheer will set up the radar trailers to monitor the speeds on those dead end streets and will report back to the Council with the results.
