ORDINANCE NO. 1206-22

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALGONA, WASHINGTON, AMENDING CHAPTER 2.72 AMC CITY HALL; DEFINING THE CITY'S LOCAL HOLIDAY SCHEDULE TO ACCURATELY REFLECT THE STATE LEGAL HOLIDAYS ESTABLISHED BY RCW 1.16.050 AND FEDERAL LAW; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, state law, including without limitation RCW 1.16.050 and RCW 35A.21.070, authorizes the City to adopt local ordinances establishing paid holidays for its employees and to define the days and hours during which the City's offices will be open for business; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend Chapter 2.72 AMC to reflect the state legal holidays established by RCW 1.16.050 as well as applicable federally-recognized holidays;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALGONA DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment of AMC 2.72.010. Section 2.72.010 of the Algona Municipal Code is hereby amended to provide in its entirety as follows:

General administrative offices and departments of the city shall be open for the transaction of business with the public from the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., five days per week, Monday through Friday, except in the event of emergency, inclement weather, or as needed in the determination of the mayor or designee, and excepting legal holidays ~~as specified by the collective bargaining agreement.~~

Section 2. Amendment of Chapter 2.72 AMC—Adoption of New Section 2.72.020. Chapter 2.72 of the Algona Municipal Code is hereby amended by the addition of a new Section 2.72.020 to provide in its entirety as follows:

2.72.020 Legal holidays.

A. The following days shall be recognized as legal holidays:

New Year's Day	January 1
Martin Luther King, Jr. Day	Third Monday of January
Presidents' Day	Third Monday of February
Memorial Day	Last Monday of May
Juneteenth	June 19
Independence Day	July 4
Labor Day	First Monday of September
Columbus Day	Second Monday of October
Veterans' Day	November 11
Thanksgiving Day	Fourth Thursday of November
Native American Heritage Day	Fourth Friday of November
Christmas Eve	December 24
Christmas Day	December 25
Floating Holiday	Provided by administrative policy

B. Whenever any legal holiday set forth in this section falls upon a Sunday, the following Monday shall be a legal holiday. Whenever any legal holiday set forth in this section falls upon a Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be a legal holiday.

C. The mayor shall have the authority to administer holidays, floating holidays, and holiday overtime schedules as provided in the city personnel policies or applicable collective bargaining agreements.

Section 3. Severability. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this ordinance be pre-empted by state or federal law or regulation, such decision or pre-emption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be published in the official newspaper of the City and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after the date of publication.
