A. 2024 Planning Commission Work Plan

City Administrator Jessica Griess opened the meeting by stating that this is a rough draft of the work plan. We are working through the Comprehensive Plan and according to Caitlin it should be done by May and moving onto council so we stay on track for passing it in time. Algona Village- We are still in rounds of comments. The conditional use permits have not been issued yet. We are waiting for them to submit for a parking

variance. The Wetland Mitigation was a suggestion for putting Wetland Mitigation banking in our city code. We will keep it on the work plan for further discussion. Broadway road extension was tabled by the planning commission due to needing more information such as is it going all the way through? Sidewalks on one side? and if it was eligible for grant money. It was decided that we needed to have a traffic study done. Streetlights- Russ stated that we are picking out a design for the downtown area It should be completed by the next planning commission meeting to vote on. We will then start to work on locations to recommend to the council. The last four items on the work plan, the progress review, misc land use permits and actions, misc zoning code amendments and annual joint meeting are ongoing.
