Recycling Voucher Program

October 1st, 2023 - December 31st, 2024

Vouchers are valid for Algona residents only



City of Algona residents can request up to four vouchers per household for the duration of the program. Not for commercial business use. Each voucher can only be used one time, per trip to either the Bow Lake or Enumclaw recycling & transfer station.

How to use your voucher

Bring your recyclable items and your voucher to Bow Lake or Enumclaw Recycling & Transfer Stations on or before the voucher expiration.

Let the scale operator know you have a voucher when you arrive. The scale operator will assist you in processing your items and submitting your voucher.

***PLEASE NOTE: If the recycling fees charged for your recyclable items are more than the voucher's value of \$30, the person whose name appears on the voucher is the responsible party for the additional costs in all instances, including transfer to another party. ***

The City of Algona will be responsible for invoicing and collecting any costs over \$30.

Large Appliances

\$30 for each refrigerant type appliance(refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners) that contains or contained refrigerants. Appliances must be empty. No commercial appliances. No fee for non-refrigerant type appliances (stoves, washers, dryers, etc.). No dishwashers made of 50% or more plastic will be accepted for recycling.

Mattresses and Box Springs

\$30 handling fee for each mattress, futon, or box spring - any size. Limit: combined total of 6 pieces per customer per day. No wet mattresses. Torn or stained ok. Residential customers only.

Yard Waste*

\$115 per ton; \$18 minimum fee (up to 320 lbs.). Includes branches, brush, grass clippings, leaves, tree stumps, wood rounds, holiday trees, and weeds. No plastic, plastic bags, glass, metal, sod, soil, or rocks. Branches: Maximum size 8' long, 4" diameter. Tree stumps, wood rounds: Maximum size 2'x2'x2'.

Clean Wood*

\$115 per ton; \$18 minimum fee (up to 320 lbs.). Only unpainted, unstained, untreated wood. Includes plywood, construction lumber, oriented strand board (OSB), pallets, particle board, crates, and lath (no plaster). No items longer than 8'. No painted, stained or treated wood. No metal hinges or latches (nails and staples are OK).

Scrap Metal*

Includes metal items made of 50% or more metal (aluminum, brass, copper, iron, and steel). No fluids. No live ammunition or spent casings. No pressurized tanks.

Textiles

Includes reusable as well as torn, worn, and stained clothing, curtains, fabric, linens, blankets, stuffed animals and small throw rugs. Single socks and shoes are accepted. No carpet, or carpet padding. No wet or mildewed items. No items contaminated with hazardous materials.

Fluorescent Lights Bulbs and Tubes

Limit 10 per vehicle, per day. Place bulbs and tubes in designated area inside the transfer building. Broken bulbs must be sealed in a bag or box. No incandescent, halogen, or LED bulbs.

Medical Sharps (Bow Lake location only)

Includes hypodermic needles, syringes and IV tubing with needles attached, scalpel blades and lancets removed from original packaging. Sharps must be in a puncture resistant, secured container labeled "sharps." Home generated sharps only. Limit two containers per visit. No loose sharps. Place in marked bin.

*Clean wood, yard waste, scrap metal, and corrugated cardboard are not accepted in garbage. Separate those materials prior to arrival and place in designated recycling areas or bins.
