



# Mayors Message

### **Upcoming Projects in 2024:**

Starting this coming Spring, the Interurban Trail from 5<sup>th</sup> Ave S to I<sup>St</sup> Ave N will be rebuilt. The trail will also be repaired from I<sup>ST</sup> Ave N to I5<sup>th</sup> St. If anyone is interested in viewing the plans, please feel free to stop by my office at City Hall.

The purchase of the empty property at the north end of Algona Blvd and Boundary Blvd should be completed by the end of this year. On the west side of Algona Blvd, we will start the process of applying for grant funding so we can put in a water retaining pond to continue to mitigate the flooding in the north end of our city. The two pieces of property on the east side of Algona Blvd and west of Celery Blvd is primarily wetlands. The portion that is buildable, we would like to put a field that can be used both as a soccer field and football field as well as a walking trail around the properties. These are just ideas at this point. We have a Community Center Advisory Board that also advises on the parks facilities. I will be looking to them for final ideas to bring before our City Council.

We will be continuing the cleanup of the 167 ditch from 5<sup>th</sup> Ave N south to the southern city limit. We are hoping to start this early spring. Our Police Department has kindly flown their drone the complete length of the 167 ditch. If you are interested in viewing the video to see what is completed and what needs to be done, please let me know.

We are in the process of issuing permits for the construction of a 120 room hotel which will be located on West Valley Hwy at the northwest corner of our city limits. Construction will start immediately.

The construction for the Algona Village project at the end of I<sup>st</sup> Ave N and West Valley Hwy should also be starting early this spring.

#### **New Ideas:**

I am looking to put a committee together to discuss what we can do to have a place in the center of our city where people would want to gather. Family restaurants, a little strip mall with three stores, a coffee shop, etc. I am thinking in the area of Milwaukee, I st AVE and Main ST.

I would also like our Community Center Advisory Board to take a look at what it would take to create a trail on the west side of the 167 ditch that would run from the southern border of our city to the north border and connect to the trail system that surrounds the wetlands that are on the west side of Algona Blvd.
